

ONLY SCHEDULED APPOINTMENTS ALLOWED IN LINE.

CONTRACTORS AND BUSINESSES ARE PROHIBITED FROM USING THIS FACILITY

- Must have current photo ID and proof of East Aldine residency see requirements.
- Children 16 and under MUST remain inside the vehicle at all times.
- · Residents must remain in vehicle until directed by staff to approach the unloading area.
- Inappropriate language and behavior will not be tolerated.
- · Salvaging and scavenging is strictly prohibited.
- NO LOITERING allowed anywhere in or around the facility by anyone at anytime.
- Alcohol, drugs and intoxicating substances are strictly prohibited. Violators will be reported to SOC.
- No pets allowed, even in vehicles. PROOF OF SERVICE ANIMAL IS REQUIRED TO BE PERMITTED ON PREMISES]
- Neighborhood Depository & Recycling Center employees should not solicit nor accept tips of any kind.
- Only two visits per month per vehicle per address.

UTILITY BILL (electric, water, gas)

No more than three months old with name and address matching the provided current photo ID



No vehicles or diesels over one ton

No trailers longer than sixteen feet

No lifts or hydraulic equipment

waste must be disposed of by hand



Staff will direct all residents to containers

Unloading is your responsibility

You will have 20 minutes to unload your waste

if more time is needed you may be asked to get back in line



NO Household Garbage

NO Dead Animals

NO Bricks, Rocks and/or Dirt

NO TVs or other Electronics

NO Truck or Industrial Tires

NO Paint, Chemicals, Household Hazardous Waste fertilizers, pesticides, flammable materials or liquids

NO Motor Oil

NO Toxic, Infectious, Hazardous Waste acid, explosives, ashes/charcoal, burned wood

NO Appliances

refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc.



TREE WASTE: branches/limbs/logs No longer than six feet | No wider than 12 inches

JUNK WASTE furniture, mattresses, clothing

WOOD FENCING: broken down with nails/screws removed

DRYWALL / SHINGLES: must be bagged

PASSENGER TIRES: ONLY four tires per month - per household

RECYCLING: cardboard, paper and approved plastics
